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DESCRIPTION

The 1947 Globe Swift GC-1B is a highly charismatic classic aircraft for sale with true post-war American aviation heritage. 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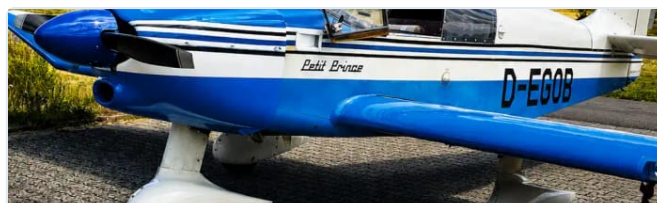


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
