This remarkable 1973 Pitts S-2A , registered D-ESLM and located in Ballenstedt, Germany , stands among the finest examples of this iconic aerobatic biplane available today. Celebrated for its agility, spirited performance and pure pilot-centric experience, the S-2A continues to enthrall enthusiasts worldwide — and this particular airframe is a standout within that storied lineage.

Technical Features & Performance

- Airframe & Engine: Lycoming-powered piston aircraft with documented maintenance and compliance — all applicable Service Bulletins (SBs) and Airworthiness Directives (ADs) completed.
- Time & Usage: Total time airframe (TTAF) approx. 1191 hrs with corresponding engine time, reflecting light use relative to age.
- Engine & Propulsion: Engine and propeller are well-serviced — SMOH 275 hrs , complete propeller overhaul in 10/2024, and high-quality components including a robust crankshaft flange.
- Upgrades & Gear: Vary rare 23 gal wing tank feature, also features include a fine oil-filter adapter, lightweight starter, vertical compass, 8.33 kHz radio, Mode S transponder, ELT and additional optimized hardware throughout.

Exterior & Interior Condition

- Exterior: Preserved in 8/10 condition , the airframe displays admirable fit and finish, with a canopy that is like new — free of cracks or scratches .
- Interior: Also rated 8/10 , comfortable and functional for both front and rear cockpits with Hooker harnesses installed, combining quality safety gear with authentic biplane character.

Maintenance & Records

This S-2A benefits from a transparent maintenance history, with evidence of diligent care and timely overhauls. Recent propeller rebuild and engine work provide confidence for continued aerobatic flying and routine operations. All updates and regulatory compliance actions have been completed, assuring prospective owners of airworthiness integrity.

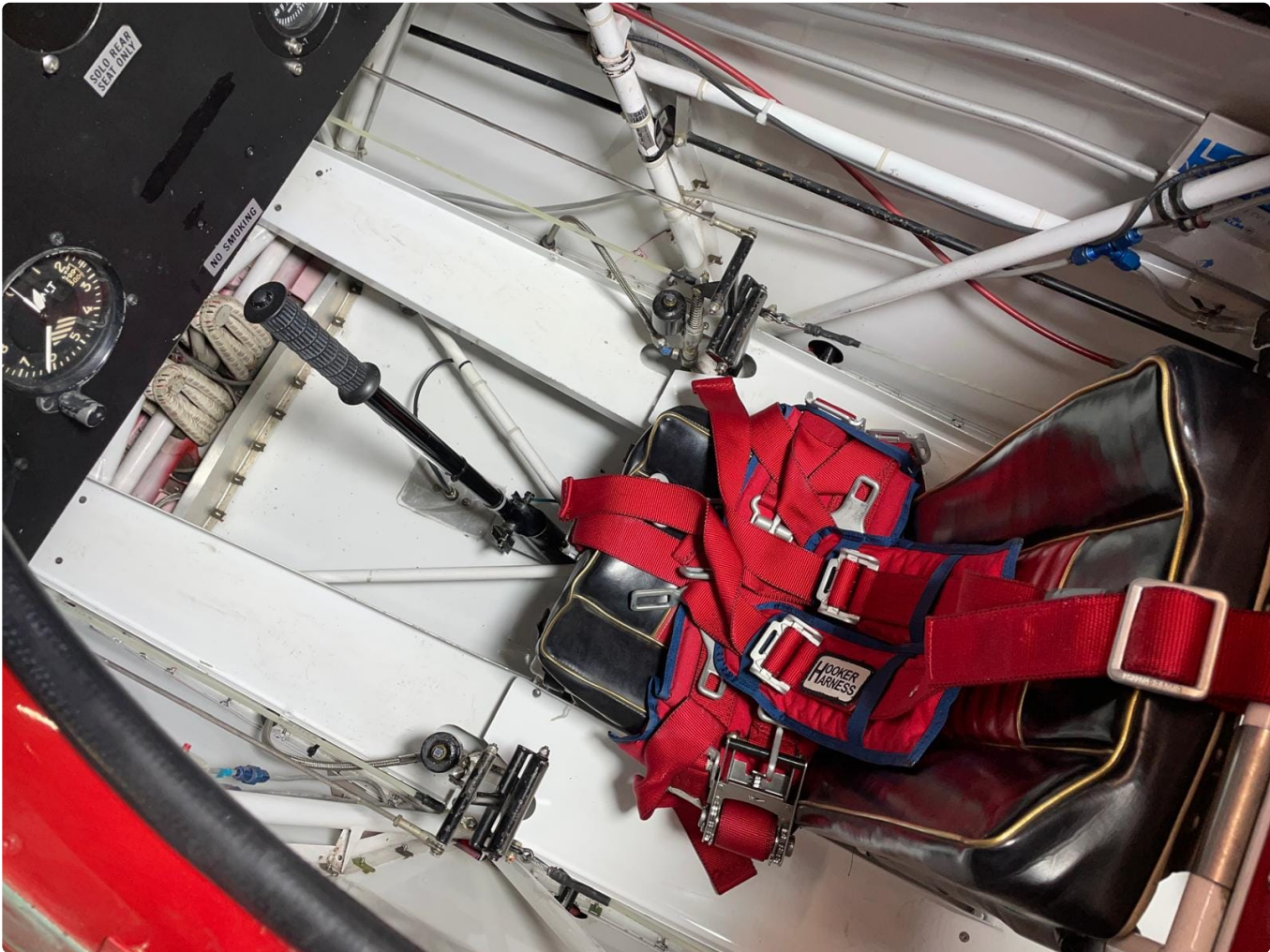

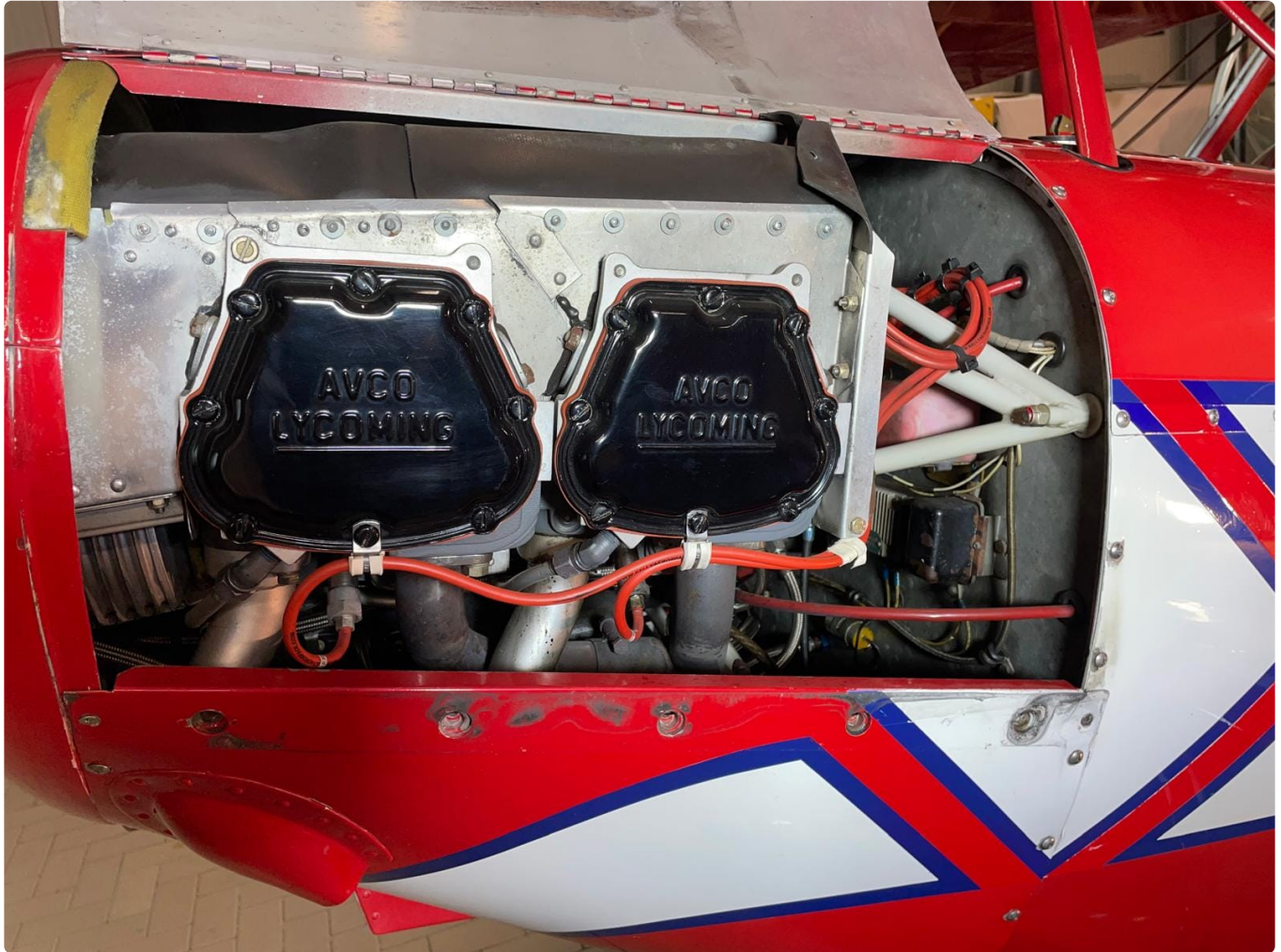

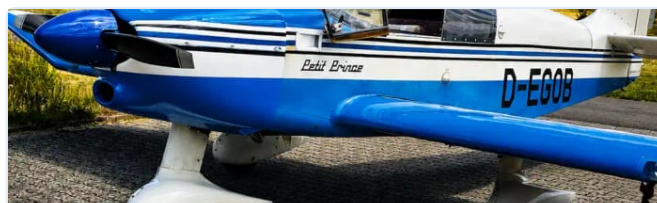
