DESCRIPTION

Polished 2000 ULBI Wild Thing WT-01 — Tailwheel Ultralight with Jabiru 3300 Power

Overview

Built in Germany at the turn of the millennium, this 2000 ULBI Wild Thing WT-01 embodies the purposeful honesty of a true back-country ultralight, refined with European craftsmanship and unmistakable character. Serial number 055 and registered D-MTTS, this example presents in striking form with an entirely polished aluminum airframe, celebrating the Wild Thing's utilitarian roots while elevating it with a timeless, aviation-forward aesthetic.

Configured in taildragger WT-01 form, the aircraft reflects a pilot-focused philosophy—simple, robust, and engaging—designed to reward hands-on flying and thoughtful stewardship.

Technical Features & Avionics

Power is provided by the Jabiru 3300, a 6-cylinder, 120 PS boxer engine well regarded for its mechanical simplicity and smooth operation in the ultralight category. This configuration offers confident performance while remaining aligned with the Wild Thing's ethos of straightforward, owner-friendly engineering.

The cockpit is equipped with classic "six-pack" flight instrumentation, delivering essential information in a familiar, intuitive layout. The result is an aircraft that prioritizes situational awareness and pilot connection over unnecessary complexity.

Exterior & Interior

The exterior is defined by its fully polished aluminum skin, lending the aircraft a distinctive presence on the ramp and underscoring its all-metal construction. The high-wing configuration, combined with rugged detailing, conveys capability and purpose without pretense.

Inside, the cabin is trimmed in brown wild leather (Wildleder), introducing warmth and tactility to an otherwise purposeful environment. The materials feel authentic and durable—entirely in keeping with the Wild Thing's adventurous spirit.

Maintenance & Equipment

This WT-01 benefits from a number of thoughtfully chosen enhancements, including reinforced landing gear with bungee suspension and large tundra tires, reinforcing its suitability for uneven or unimproved surfaces. A tow hitch is fitted, adding versatility for ground handling or auxiliary tasks such as glider towing.

While detailed maintenance logs are not presented here, the aircraft's configuration and presentation suggest careful ownership, with modifications that respect the original design intent rather than compromise it.

The Perfect Airplane For

This ULBI Wild Thing WT-01 is ideally suited for the pilot who values mechanical honesty, tactile flying, and understated individuality. It will appeal to ultralight enthusiasts seeking a capable tailwheel aircraft with character, to collectors drawn to distinctive European designs, and to aviators who appreciate the quiet satisfaction of polished metal, simple systems, and purposeful flight.

An aircraft for those who believe that the most rewarding flying is often the most direct.

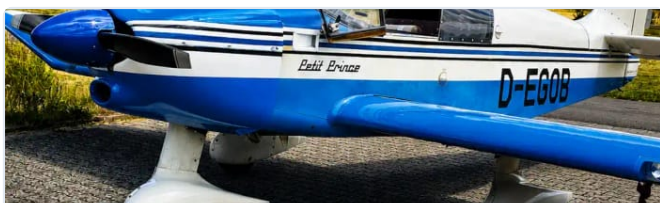
