DESCRIPTION

CollectAirs.com is pleased to present this rare 1957 Dornier Do 27 B1, a distinguished example of post-war German aviation engineering. Conceived as a rugged yet refined utility aircraft, the Do 27 earned its reputation through exceptional versatility, short-field performance, and enduring structural integrity. With a total airframe time of just 4,030 hours, this aircraft stands today as a compelling testament to careful stewardship and thoughtful operation across nearly seven decades.

Technical Features & Avionics

At the heart of this Do 27 B1 is a Lycoming GO-480-B1A6 engine, delivering dependable performance and recently renewed with just 25 hours since overhaul, completed on 22 May 2023. Power is transmitted through a Hartzell HC82V20-1B propeller, overhauled in March 2004 and showing 846 hours since overhaul.

The avionics suite is purposefully simple and functional, aligned with the aircraft's authentic character while supporting modern operational requirements:

- Garmin GTR 225 COM
- Trig Mode S transponder

Exterior & Interior

The Dornier Do 27's unmistakable silhouette reflects its utilitarian roots — purposeful, balanced, and enduring. The high-wing configuration, robust landing gear, and expansive glazing offer excellent visibility and confidence-inspiring ground handling. Inside, the cockpit remains true to the aircraft's original mission, presenting a practical and honest environment that emphasizes clarity, durability, and connection to the flying experience.

Maintenance & Documentation

This aircraft benefits from a well-defined maintenance status, highlighted by a valid ARC through 19 November 2026, offering reassurance to its next custodian. The low-time engine overhaul further underscores its readiness for continued operation, whether for private flying, collection, or historic appreciation.

The Perfect Airplane For

This Dornier Do 27 B1 is ideally suited for the discerning aviator or collector who values authenticity, heritage, and mechanical honesty. It will appeal to those drawn to classic utility aircraft, vintage European engineering, and machines that tell a genuine story through use rather than excess. For pilots seeking a distinctive taildragger with character and capability, this Do 27 represents an increasingly rare opportunity.

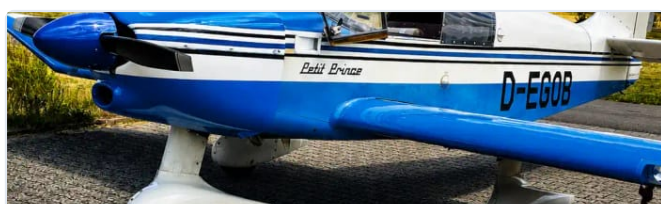
