Powerplant, Systems & Technical Highlights

The aircraft is powered by a Lycoming IO-540-K1G5D six-cylinder engine producing 300 horsepower. The engine has accumulated 1,165 hours since its major overhaul, which was completed in November 2012, and has a published TBO of 2,000 hours.

The two-blade constant-speed propeller was overhauled in 2020 and has accumulated only 112 hours since overhaul.

The aircraft is equipped for IFR operations with Garmin GNS 530 navigation equipment, S-TEC autopilot, and ILS capability. Additional equipment includes air conditioning, electric trim, and a second altimeter.

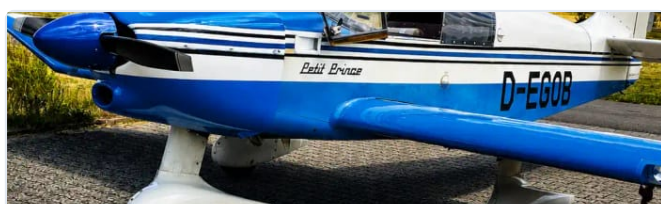
