The wide cabin and large glazed surfaces create excellent outward visibility, particularly beneficial during slow-speed operations and tight field approaches.

Inside, the cockpit is designed with simplicity and functionality in mind. The layout emphasizes easy access to controls, clear instrumentation, and a spacious side-by-side seating arrangement. Depending on configuration, aircraft may feature traditional analog gauges or modern glass cockpit upgrades, allowing builders to tailor the avionics to their mission needs and budget.

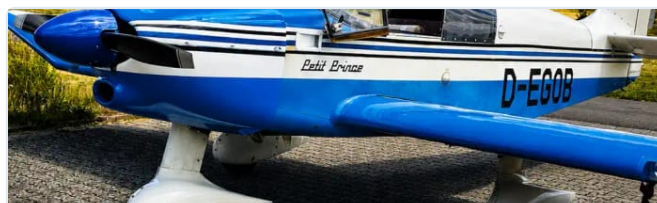
